Business related activities:

Telkom overhead lines:

Meetings were held with Telkom requesting the removal of unsightly overhead infrastructure. Indications were that there is still properties on the estate utilizing Telkom infrastructure.





MESSAGE FROM THE ESTATE MANAGER *Fiber installation:*

The provision of fiber in the estate started in October and is now ready to be connected. Households will be connected at the box provided on the boundary of each plot in January 2023



Street name project:

At the 2021 AGM it was recommended that the curbstone street names be replaced with proper road name signage. Meetings were held with those tourism facilities that have consent use from the Municipality. A number of facilities financed phase 1 of the street sign project.






Security:
